## REPUBLIC OF LIBERIA COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR TRAVELERS Effective May 11, 2022

## **Incoming Travelers:**

- 1. All travelers must complete the Health Screening Form via the Liberia Travel application ("Lib travel app") at <a href="http://liberiacovidtravel.org">http://liberiacovidtravel.org</a>. Anyone experiencing problems with the app can access copy of the form via the National Public Health Institute of Liberia website @nphil.gov.lr.
- 2. All travelers 18 years and above **MUST** show proof of COVID-19 vaccination upon arrival. Travelers without proof of vaccination will be returned to their country of embarkation at the expense of the airline.
- 3. No negative COVID-19 test result is required for travelers exiting countries that have suspended testing for travelers.
- 4. No COVID test is required for incoming travelers at the airport.

## **Outgoing Travelers:**

ALL travelers must check the COVID-19 guidelines and regulations of the destination country.

- 1. All persons traveling out of Liberia are encouraged to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and follow the COVID-19 protocol requirement(s) of the destination country.
- 2. All persons traveling to countries that require a COVID-19 test must present a negative COVID-19 test certificate before departure.
  - a. COVID-19 sample collection (testing) for PCR and RDT is available at the Union Center located on Sophia Road in Congo Town, Monrovia from 9 am to 4 pm, 7 days a week. Travelers are encouraged to register at <a href="http://liberiacovidtravel.org">http://liberiacovidtravel.org</a> prior to arrival at the Union Center. To register, select "Request a Travel Certificate" and fill out the requested information. Travelers should ensure they provide correct contact details and will receive a unique identification number

to retrieve their test result online (<a href="http://liberiacovidtravel.org">http://liberiacovidtravel.org</a>). Travelers should print a paper copy of their negative test result certificate before arriving at the Roberts International Airport.

- b. Testing fees for Outgoing travelers that require COVID travel Certificate: ECOWAS citizens traveling to ECOWAS Countries must pay US\$50 for cost of COVID-19 testing while those traveling outside the ECOWAS region must pay US\$75. Payments can either be made online or in cash at the UBA banking window at the Union Testing Center.
- c. Travelers who test positive will be denied travel and must adhere to Liberia's COVID-19 Case Management Guidelines. A re-test will be conducted on day five (5) based on the case prevailing health status.
